Conclusions:

1. The first proposal of the expert scientific group is for the next phase to re-review the Reference List of species and habitats for B&H according to Annexes of HD. It has been

agreed that the Reference list of habitats and species present in BiH from the Annexes of Habitat Directive should be amended with some species and habitats that have been omitted during the First phase of this project. The proposal is to send the Reference list to a larger number of the experts in the country to check once more the presence of the species and habitats in B&H in according to the Annexes of EU Nature Directives and Interpretation Manual for Habitats. The following habitat is concluded during the workshop that should be added on the Reference list of B&H:

- 4080 Sub-arctic Salix spp. scrub

2. For the list of suggestions on possible amendments proposed by B&H to Annexes of the Habitats Directive from a scientific perspective, the following have been proposed:

Flora:

- Lonicera glutinosa
- Viburnum maculatum
- Lilium cattaniae
- Edraianthus
- Saxifraga prenja
- Daphne malyana
- Pancicia serbica

Fauna:

- Coenonympha gardeta - Invertebrate
- Zerynthia cerisyi – Invertebrate

Habitats:

- Omorika spruce forests
- Peridotitsko-serpentinski masivi (ultramafitski masivi) ofiolitska zona / Pine forests on ultramafites

The text of explanation why these species and habitats have been proposed for the amendments would be prepared soon.

3. It would be very relevant for the next phase to work on the field surveys for the below proposed areas, so as on capacity building on Designation Process for Natura 2000 and Management of protected Areas for the Administration representatives of different ministries which are all in charge for nature protection (to organize the inter-sectoral workshop for the discussion and to present to the public administration, as well as to NGOs the scientific results of the project).

Proposal for next phases of this (and eventually other) project(s) is to focus on the following priority areas for upcoming field inventories:

- Neum –Klek Littoral-coastal area
- Orien orographic Meditteranean area near Trebinje
- Swamp areas near Bijeljina
- Konjuh geomorphologic phenomena (Živinice area)
- Borja
- Prenj-Čvrsnica –Čabulja

- Trnovo area
 - West part of Bosnia from Šator to Plješevica
4. It has been concluded that the issue of wolf is very specific, because it is not rare species and people do hunt it, and it has been recognized as very dominant species for N2K areas designation in BiH (according to HD rule of 60% for priority species). The experts have been agreed to have a proposal to the ministries for the wolf to be protected only in the areas like National parks and other types of protected areas. Wolf habitats should not be delineated according to HD.
