(part-time, based in Lviv, WWF Ukraine office)

The Wildlife Communications Officer will be responsible for enhancing and contributing to the communication activities and information actions of the LIFE EuroLargeCarnivores, as well as other wildlife projects as required.

The job position will report to WWF-DCP Ukraine Senior Project Officer, and it will be based in Lviv.

Your duties will include:

- Finalising and implementing the communication plan in accordance with the requirements of the LIFE EuroLargeCarnivores project in Ukraine.
- Campaigning and PR responsibilities at local and national levels, including support in organising workshops, trainings, media and other events within the project according to the strategic plans on national and regional level.
- Providing advice and support on matters related to communications and external relations for national project staff.
- Building and maintaining reputation, brand, and influential behaviour with key internal and external audiences and stakeholders covering related communication areas.
- Coordinating development of printed materials such as posters, factsheets, booklets for different target groups, information boards, reports.
- Social media support and contribution to the project website's maintenance.
- Maintaining photo and video archives, collection of clippings and communication reporting.

We expect from you:

- Knowledge: Advanced qualifications or university degree in PR/communication/marketing with at least 2 – 3 years of communication/marketing experience. The Communication Officer should have good knowledge of communication, PR and marketing and have an understanding of

biodiversity conservation and sustainable development issues particularly with regard to Ukraine. Certificates from Google adwords academy, Facebook blueprint, KAMA would be a plus.
