

| Italy       | Climate neutrality by 2050 not set in law, only envisaged in national LTS ( <u>modelling</u> of 84-87% emissions reduction by 2050). |
| Lithuania   | Climate neutrality by 2050 not set in law but in the national LTS and  |
|             | the <u>National Climate Change Management Agenda</u> .   |
| Malta       | Carbon neutrality by 2050 not set in law, only envisaged in national LTS.  |
| Slovakia    | Climate neutrality by 2050 not set in law, only envisaged in national  |
|             | LTS (modelling of 70-80% emissions reduction by 2050).   |
| Denmark     | Climate neutrality by 2050 in <u>law</u> .   |
| France      | Carbon neutrality by 2050 in <u>law</u> .  |
| Greece      | Legislation under way to set climate neutrality by 2050.   |
| Hungary     | Climate neutrality by 2050 in <u>law</u> .   |
| Ireland     | Climate neutrality by 2050 in law. Ireland has not submitted its   |
|             | national LTS.  |
| Latvia      | Legislation <u>under way</u> to set climate neutrality by 2050.  |
